

CURRICULUM VITAE OF CSABA DZSINICH MD, PhD, FICA

He graduated „Summa cum Laude” from the Semmelweis University Budapest **1967**.
He was appointed between 1967 and 1969 at the Institute of Experimental Medicine of the Hungarian Academy of Sciences .

1969 he joined to the 4th Surgical Department of the Semmelweis University and completed his surgical training

1972 he passed the board examination in general surgery with excellent qualification.

1973 he started his training in vascular surgery

1975-76 he was awarded by a fellowship of the Alexander von Humboldt Foundation in Germany and worked at the Ludwig Maximilian University in Munich.

He had been qualified as vascular surgeon 1976 by Professor Georg Heberer.

1976 he returned to Hungary and introduced the modern vascular surgical techniques in his home institution.

His surgical Department became the chair of Cardiovascular Surgery and National Institute of Vascular Surgery. The Department got the duty to organize the vascular surgical service all over the country.

1978 he was nominated as assistant professor of surgery and head of division of vascular surgery.

Dr. Dzsinič became the program director of vascular surgical training **1980**, when Hungary introduced the secondary specialty examination. Since then he has been doing this job in his home country.

1983 he was visiting professor at the Mayo Clinic.

1984 he made his academic degree with his thesis „Surgical treatment of renovascular hypertension.

1989 he got the position as associate professor of surgery at his University Department.

1990-1991 he was invited to the Mayo Clinic and appointed as research associate at Division of Vascular Surgery . He made intensive research on spinal cord protection during thoracoabdominal aortic surgery.

Since **1994** he is full professor of surgery. He has performed more than 11000 operations on the vascular system. He started in Hungary the carotid , visceral, renal reconstructions, thoracoabdominal aortic ,aortic arch replacements and reconstructive venous surgery. He is also the pioneer of hybrid operations of the thoracic aorta in Hungary.

2002 he was decorated by the Batthyanyi-Strattman Award given by the Government of the Hungarian Republic

2005 The Hungarian Society for Surgery honored him by the **János Balassa medal**

2006 he got the **Hemingway Award**

2007 he left the University and joined to the **Department of Cardiovascular and Thoracic Surgery at the STATE MEDICAL CENTER OF HUNGARY**
